Stop at Kyoto Central Masjid for prayer. Next, visit Gion Street, Ninenzaka and Sannenzaka for shopping activity. Afterwards, transfer to Fushimi Inari. It is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings. Head to hotel for check in. Overnight in Osaka.

### Day 2 Osaka – Nara – Osaka

**Breakfast**

After breakfast, depart to Nara to visit Nara Deer Park that has become the symbol of the city and designated as a natural treasure. Next, enjoy shopping at Naramachi Shopping Street. Stop at Osaka Mosque for prayer. Next, photo-stop at Osaka Castle. The castle is one of Japan's most famous landmarks and it played a major role in the unification of Japan during the sixteenth century of the Azuchi-Momoyama period. Afterwards, head to Shinsaibashi and Dotonburi. Shinsaibashi-suji has been Osaka's most important shopping area for 400 years, with hundreds of shops lining this 600-meter-long street. Transfer back to hotel. Overnight in Osaka.

### Day 3 Osaka

**Breakfast**

Breakfast at the hotel. Vehicle available on standby from 8.30 a.m – 7.30 p.m for you to explore Osaka. Overnight in Osaka.

### Day 4 Osaka

**Breakfast**

Breakfast at the hotel. Today is free at your own leisure. Overnight in Osaka.

After breakfast and check-out from the hotel. You are free at leisure until your transfer to airport for departure.
